



Conditions of participation

Participation in the ELECTRIS competition by Hoffmann Frères Energie et Bois s.à r.l., hereinafter referred to as the operator or organiser, is free of charge and is governed exclusively by these conditions of participation.

Course of the competition

The competition runs from 15.04.2023 to 15.05.2023. During this period, users can participate in the competition online.

Participation

In order to participate in the competition, it is necessary to fill in and send the displayed participation form. Participation is only possible during the participation period. Entries received after the entry deadline will not be taken into account in the draw.

Only one entry per participant will be entered into the competition. It is strictly forbidden to use multiple e-mail addresses to increase the chances of winning.

Participation in the competition is free of charge.

Authorised participation

Natural persons and employees of legal entities who are domiciled or have their registered office in Luxembourg and who are at least 14 years old are entitled to participate. Participation is not limited to customers of the organiser and is not dependent on the purchase of a good or service.

If a participant has limited legal capacity, the agreement of his/her legal representative is required.

Persons involved in the design and implementation of the competition, employees of the operator and their family members are not entitled to participate in the competition. Furthermore, the operator reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to exclude persons from participation if there are legitimate reasons, for example

(a) in the event of manipulation in connection with access to or the running of the competition, (b) in the event of a breach of these terms and conditions of participation, (c) in the event of unfairness or (d) in the event of false or misleading information in connection with participation in the competition.

Winning, notification and prize delivery

Data protection

The organiser points out that all personal data of the participant will neither be passed on to third parties nor made available to them for use without their consent.

In the event of a win, the winner agrees to the publication of his/her name and place of residence in the advertising media used by the organiser. This includes the announcement of the winner on the website of the Operator and its social media platforms.

The participant may revoke his/her declared consent at any time. After revocation of consent, the participant's personal data collected and stored will be deleted immediately.

Applicable law

Severability clause

In place of the invalid provision, the legally permissible provision that comes closest in economic terms to the meaning and purpose expressed in the invalid provision shall apply. The same applies in the event of a loophole in these conditions of participation.
